



Who is Jesus Christ?

John 3:16, the most famous verse in the Bible tells us that:

“God so loved the world that He gave his only begotten that whoever believes on Him would not perish but would have everlasting life”

This verse tells us three things about the person and work of Jesus:

1. He is the Son of God, in fact Jesus is God in the flesh. John 1: 14, 18
14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth. 18 No man hath seen God at any time, the only begotten Son, which is in the bosom of the Father, he hath declared him.
2. He is the Savior of the world- Matt. 1:21
21 And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins.
3. He is the source of life- John 1:3-5
3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. 4 In him was life; and the life was the light of men. 5 And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.

Is the Bible accurate?

The bible is unlike any book ever written and that is because it is the word of God.

The accuracy, verity, and validity of the bible is for the believer without a doubt; and yet there are those who doubt and question the reliability and accuracy of the scriptures.

There are three tests that one can use to judge the accuracy of the bible they are:

1. The historical test- the bible was written over a period of 1600, by several dozen various writers and yet it remains the most read and best loved book of all times.
2. The scientific test- almost every year, archeologist, scientist, researchers are making new discoveries that again and again point to and prove the reliability of God's word



3. The experiential test- this may well be the most significant proof of the accuracy of God's word and that is the change that it has made in the lives of so many. Millions can attest to the power of God's word in their lives.

How do you know Jesus wasn't lying

The simple answer to that is this, people do not willingly die for a known lie!

Many of the disciples, who would have known if Jesus was a fraud, suffered terrible and horrific deaths; they did it out of love and loyalty for Jesus. Had he been a fraud they would never have died for His cause.

Why should I choose Jesus?

Suppose that you were drowning and someone who could save you said, the only way to be rescued is for you to grab this rope and trust me to bring you out of the water. You would be unwise to say, I don't want to grab the rope, get me a branch instead. The same is true about salvation.

1. God has told us that the only way to Him is through the son, Jesus Christ. Phillipians 2:9-10

9Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: 10That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;
